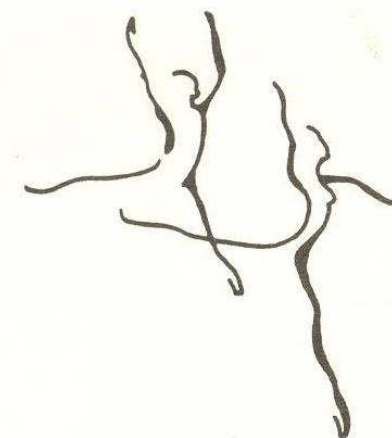

Curriculum

Ballet Arts, Inc. will present it's annual summer intensive workshop June 14th to June 25th. The two week intensive schedule will be excellent for the serious student that is motivated to work hard and be exposed to instruction from various teachers.

Auditions will not be necessary for Ballet Arts members. Others may need to attend an audition class for level suitability prior to the start of the workshop.

Placement level will be at the evaluation of the faculty. Students must be age 12-20 for the regular sessions and 9 1/2 to 12 for the mini session.



Students should try to attend two weeks for maximum achievement but may attend only one week if they desire. Out of town students can be housed with host families. Classes are from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.(9 a.m. to 3:30 for mini intensive) with lunch provided. Classes in ballet, modern, jazz, conditioning, variations, Pointe, theory and history classes will be planned. Evening activities may be planned as an added bonus.

Kevin Martin

Kevin comes from a family of dancers. His acceptance into the John Barker School the noted Vaganova authority would mark the beginning of a life-time of performing, teaching and mentoring to many dancers to come. The Russian ballet program was six years long, preparing him to dance and *teach* . In the years from 1981 until 1996, Kevin Martin would dance in 38 states for 2 dozens different ballet companies. From 1992 until 2007, Kevin Martin held the position of Ballet Master at the Nutmeg Conservatory. He is now a consultant to several ballet organizations and a master class instructor

Ms. Wojtowicz began her training with Sylvia Hamer, in the Cecchetti Method of Ballet. She furthered her studies at Texas Christian and received her BFA degree in ballet.. Emily Patterson- Nicholas

Emily is originally from Connecticut and trained at Nutmeg Conservatory since the age of three. She was hired by American Ballet Theatre's Studio Company after winning the Leftkowitz award at the New York International Ballet Competition in 1996. After two seasons in New York, she joined Joffrey Ballet and went on to dance principle roles for eleven seasons.

Thomas Nicholas

Thomas began his dance training at the Ithaca Ballet School in New York State. He attended New School University and trained with Davis Howard. After attaining his BFA, he was hired by Joffrey Ballet. Thomas is in his 6th season with the company..

Nora Cherry

Nora is from Franklin, TN. Nora performed in NYC and throughout Europe, most notably with the Broadway musical, Cats. She served as dance captain and directly assisted original choreographer Gillian Lynne with productions in Vienna and Amsterdam. She is currently on the summer faculty of the Nashville Ballet. .
